

Minutes of the Albion Special City Council Meeting Held October 28, 2024

CALL TO ORDER – The meeting was called to order at 7:08 pm at the Albion Civic Center by Mayor Isaac Loveland.

AGENDA ITEMS

1 – Review Quote for Sewer Lift Station Replacement Pump and Approve Purchase of New Pump.

Mayor Loveland said the Pump at the Lift Station has quit working; he noted that the pump was installed approximately 10 years ago. This being an emergency situation a new Pump has been ordered and should arrive by the end of next week. The city would like to order one more pump to have a back-up in case of a similar instance of the pump failing and the time it takes to be approved, ordered, and shipped, at a cost of \$4,819.50 each; as well as hiring a certified technician to install the pump. Mayor Loveland asked the Council if they approve of the current expenditure of the New Replacement Pump of \$4,819.50. A motion was made by Council President Lloyd to approve the purchase and installment of the new Lift Station Pump. Motion was seconded by Councilperson Winder and passed with a vote of: Lloyd – aye, Winder – aye, and Tolman - aye.
