

TITLE 10 CHAPTER 2

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

SECTION:

10-2-1: Parking

1022: Towing and Storage of Impounded Motor Vehicles

1023: Penalty

10-2-1: PARKING:

(A) Parking on Sidewalk: No vehicle shall travel or park upon any sidewalk provided that vehicles may cross sidewalks at authorized curb cuts, and at alleys.

(B) Running Motors In Parked Cars; Set Brakes: No person having control or charge of a vehicle shall allow such a vehicle to stand on any street or highway unattended without stopping the motor of said vehicle, and effectively setting the brakes thereon.

(C) Parking Vehicles With Offensive Odor Loads: It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on the City streets when such vehicle is loaded with any material offensive to human smell.

(D) Leaving Vehicles on Streets: No unlicensed automobile, truck, trailer, boat, mobile home, camper, motor home, or similar type of vehicle shall remain continuously parked or left on any street of the city for more than twenty four hours at any time, and in the event of any such parking for more than forty eight hours the Cassia County Sheriffs Department as authorized by the City of Albion, has authority to impound said vehicle, trailer, boat, tractor, motorcycle, mobile home, camper, motor home, bus or similar type vehicle, and remove the same; provided however, that the Cassia County Sheriffs Department, as authorized by the City of Albion, gives written notice of its intention to do so to the purported or registered owner of the vehicle, at least twenty four hours prior to the time the unlicensed automobile, trailer, boat, mobile home, camper, motor home, or similar type of vehicle is so removed. Such notice shall be given by an officer of Cassia County Sheriffs Department, placing in a prominent place on said vehicle a written notice of its intention to impound said vehicle, or by delivering a copy of said notice personally to the purported owner of the vehicle, or by both such posting and delivery.

1022: TOWING AND STORAGE OF IMPOUNDED MOTOR VEHICLES:

(A) Costs and expenses of taking and keeping, including the towing and storage of any motor vehicle which is impounded or taken into its custody and control by the Cassia County Sheriffs Department under the authority of any law in the State of Idaho, or ordinance of the City of Albion, shall be assessed by the City of Albion against such motor vehicle, and shall constitute a lien in favor of the City or its agent, and against such vehicle.

(B) The City Council may by resolution authorize the Cassia County Sheriffs Department or other city employees to enter into an agreement with an auto storage company for the towing and

storage of the impounded vehicles taken into custody by the Cassia County Sheriffs Department, as herein provided.

(C) Any person claiming possession of motor vehicle shall pay to the City, or its duly authorized depository all costs including storage assessed against such vehicle prior to time of receiving possession of the same.

1023: PENALTY: Any person violating the terms of this Chapter will be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor which shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and/or a period of incarceration in the County Jail, not to exceed six (6) months.
