6-2-1: FIRE PREVENTION CODE ADOPTED: There is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating and controlling the maintenance of buildings and premises; to safeguard life, health, property and public welfare by regulating the storage, use and handling of dangerous and hazardous materials, substances and processes, and by regulating the maintenance of adequate egress facilities of the City, the Uniform Fire Code, 1994 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials and the Western Fire Chiefs Association, 1994 Edition thereof, and as the same may hereafter be revised or amended. The same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an ordinance of the City as fully as though set forth at length herein, three (3) copies of said Uniform Fire Code, 1994 Edition, together with all amendments thereto, duly certified by the City Clerk, being kept on file in his office for use and examination of and by the public.

6-2-2: LIFE SAFETY CODE ADOPTED: There is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating and controlling life safety of the City the Life Code, 1994, published by the National Fire Protection Association, 1994 Edition, thereof and as the same may hereafter be revised or amended. The same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an ordinance of the City as fully a though set forth at length herein, three (3) copies of said Life Safety Code, 1994 together with all amendments thereto, duly certified by the City Clerk, being kept on file in his office for use and examination of and by the public.
