- 4-4-1: ADOPTION OF CODE: There is hereby adopted the Northwest Energy Code, 1990 Edition of the Model Conservation Standards Equivalent Code to Chapter 53 of the Uniform Building Code, and the Conversion Standards (Chapter 53 of the Uniform Building Code Format) as such Model Conservation Standards are created by the Northwest Power Planning Council.
- 4-4-2: CODE ON FILE: Three (3) copies of the Northwest Energy Code, 1990 Edition as adopted in Section 1 are on file and available for public inspection during normal office hours in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Albion.
- 4-4-3: ADMINISTRATION OF CODE: The Northwest Energy Code will be administered in accordance with Chapters 1, 2, and 3 of the current edition of the Uniform Building Code. It is the intention of the City of Albion that the cost of enforcement of the provisions of, and monetary reimbursement for early adoption of this code, shall be provided by the Bonneville Power Administration.
- 4-4-4: VIOLATION: Each violation of this ordinance or of any regulation, order or ruling promulgated hereunder shall constitute a misdemeanor.
- (A) Drain Into Sewers: Every owner or occupant of any building within the City who maintains an air conditioner or other any other device which is operated by water or permits an accumulation of water must provide a direct connection from such air conditioner or such device to the sanitary sewer in the building or to the storm sewer for the disposal of the excess water.
- (B) Drain Upon Alleys or Streets: It shall be unlawful for anyone to discharge or permit water to be discharged in and upon the alleys or streets of the City, other than that which is incident to the natural precipitation drainage from roofs.
