**Area Previously Affected: Any City of Albion public water service located on the southern side of Market St. that have lost pressure on Thursday, March 5, 2026.**

### Boil Water Advisory Has Been Lifted

The **Boil Water Advisory** issued on **03/05/2026** for any **City of Albion public water service located on the southern side of Market St. that had lost pressure on Thursday, March 5, 2026.**

Laboratory testing has confirmed that the drinking water meets all safe drinking water standards and is now safe to drink without boiling. The system has completed corrective actions and bacteriological testing as required in coordination with the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality.

### What Was Done to Resolve the Issue

The water system has completed the following actions:

- Repaired the affected water main/system component
- Restored and stabilized system pressure
- Flushed and disinfected the distribution system
- Collected bacteriological samples confirming safe water quality

---

### Recommended Steps for Residents

Although the water is safe to drink, it is recommended that customers take the following steps:

1. **Flush household plumbing**
  - Run cold water taps for **5 minutes** to clear stagnant water.
2. **Discard ice**
  - Throw away ice made during the advisory.
3. **Flush appliances**
  - Run dishwashers and washing machines once if they were used during the advisory.
  - Replace or rinse refrigerator water filters if applicable.
4. **Water heaters**
  - Run hot water until it turns over fresh water in the tank.
